





THEORETICAL AND PRACTICAL

The esthetic implant rehabilitation of patients with esthetically and functionally compromised teeth frequently involves a multidisciplinary approach and is a clinical challenge. In recent years, treatment methods and options have changed and less invasive nonsurgical procedures are used in order to preserve soft tissue anatomy and minimize recession. The design of implants and prosthetic components have changed to minimize bone resorption and soft tissue alterations. This course will give practical guidelines that can be easily used in day-to-day clinical practice to learn basic bone regeneration techniques and soft tissue management around implants in order to help maximize peri-implant esthetics as well as long-term predictability and up to date prosthetic protocols. Treatment algorithms will be outlined to help guide the clinician to choose the various procedures and techniques to predictably meet patient expectations.

Hands-on on pig jaws for bone regeneration techniques and soft tissue management will be provided.




